1. INTRODUCTION TO THE NRF

The National Research Foundation Act as amended, Act 19 of 2018, establishes the National Research Foundation (“NRF”) as the juristic legal entity that will contract with the awarded bidder. Please visit the NRF website (<https://www.nrf.ac.za>) for more information.

2. BACKGROUND TO SARAO

The South African Radio Astronomy Observatory (SARAO, formerly in part SKA SA) is the business unit of the National Research Foundation (NRF) that houses and operates South Africa’s national radio telescope shared facilities, including the MeerKAT, KAT-7, and Hartbeeshoek 26-m radio telescopes.

As a member of the international effort to build the Square Kilometre Array (SKA), which will be the world’s largest radio telescope, South Africa (through the NRF’s business units) is responsible for the construction and operation of the MeerKAT precursor telescope, for hosting the SKA Mid Frequency telescope, and for implementation of the African VLBI Network.

SARAO has offices based in Johannesburg and Cape Town, as well as the radio-quiet SKA host site in the Karoo, 90km from Carnarvon in the Northern Cape, which hosts the Square Kilometre Array mid-frequency telescopes, MeerKAT, and KAT-7 radio telescope installations, as well as a number of guest instruments, including the HERA telescope.

3. SUPPLY SPECIFICATIONS

As part of its agreement to host the SKA_MID part of the project, SARAO has agreed to provide the Science Processing Centre (SPC), which will include all the facilities required to house the computing hardware for the SKA1_MID Science Data Processing (SDP), the SOC and new SARAO Headquarters, which forms part of the SKA_MID telescope. The SOC and new SARAO Headquarters will collectively be referred to as the Cape Town Operations Centre (CTOC), and the SPC and SRC will collectively be referred to as the High-Performance Computing Building (HPCB). The Cape Town Operations Centre (CTOC) and High-Performance Computing Building (HPCB) will form part of the Cape Town Hosting Infrastructure System (CTHIS) facilities.

SARAO has entered into a Co-Location Agreement (Co-LA) with iThemba LABS to facilitate the establishment of the CTHIS at iThemba LABS in Cape Town. SARAO and SKAO have identified a requirement to deploy a Fibre Shelter (FS) to facilitate the installation and testing of a new backhaul Fibre Cable to be installed as part of the CTHIS Facility. As part of the deployed Fibre

Shelter, SARAO requires the appointment of a qualified and registered service provider to supply, construct and test concrete piles for the stabilisation of the subbase structure and concrete plinth to the CTHIS Fibre Shelter, and to prevent the structure from sinking further and the subbase from washing away.

SARAO and SKAO have identified a requirement to deploy a Fibre Shelter (FS) to facilitate the installation and testing of a new backhaul Fibre Cable to be installed as part of the CTHIS Facility. As part of the deployed Fibre Shelter, SARAO requires the appointment of a qualified and registered service provider to supply, construct and test concrete piles for the stabilisation of the subbase structure and concrete plinth to the CTHIS Fibre Shelter.

Service Deliverables

The scope of work for this project entails the following deliverables -

- (i) Remove sand & stone from corners and middle of the plinth subbase;
- (ii) Trench foundation - 800mm deep x 600mm wide;
- (iii) Install Y12 steel reinforcement;
- (iv) Build 430mm column & fill with concrete;
- (v) Repeat for all 4 corners, middle and in between slabs;
- (vi) Build total of 8 steel reinforced concrete columns;
- (vii) Remove steel fence construction around shelter & reinstall fence on completion;
- (viii) Supply and inject sealant to the Fibre and electrical cable holes on the concrete plinth to prevent water ingress into to Fibre duct and manhole.

Timelines

The commencement date will be confirmed following the contract award to the successful bidder. All drawings and reports shall be provided three (3) weeks after completion date.
