Functionality: Only tenderers who score a minimum of **70** out of **100** points on Functionality will be considered responsive and be evaluated further on the basis of the **80/20** points system, in terms of Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 and the regulations pertaining thereto, as well as the Koukamma Local Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy. The guidelines for locally produced or manufactured goods with a stipulated minimum threshold where applicable will be applied.

Tender documents may be obtained from the Koukamma Local Municipality, 5 Keet Street, Kareedouw, 6400 from **Friday 30 July 2021** during office hours. Documents will only be issued upon receipt of payment of the non-refundable tender participation fee of **R350.00** (VAT inclusive). This is an eligibility criterion and is payable via:

- Cash or bank-certified cheques, payable to "Koukamma Local Municipality" at the municipal cashier's counter at 5 Keet Street, Kareedouw, 6400; or
- Direct deposit with proof of payment submitted to SCM two (2) full business days before collection and also to be presented upon collection of documents.

NB: A compulsory clarification meeting with the representatives of the Employer and the Consulting Engineers will take place at 09h00 am on Tuesday, the **10th of August 2021** at the Koukamma Local Municipality premises situated at 08 Oliver Street, Joubertina, 6410.

Attendance and completion of the attendance register is compulsory for all tenderers. Tenderers must appear on the attendance register to be considered as being present. Note that Tenderers who are more than 15 minutes late for the meeting will not be allowed to attend the meeting and will not be allowed to sign the attendance register. Companies must make sure that they send only one representative who must at all times wear a mask and adhere to the instructions that will be given to them on the clarification meeting day to ensure compliance to Covid-19 regulations.

Tenderers shall take note of the following:

1. Completed tender documents must be submitted in a **sealed envelope**, endorsed with the project name, tender number and description must be deposited in the Tender Box at the Koukamma Local Municipality, 05 Keet Street, Kareedouw, 6400 not later than **12h00 on Friday, 03 September 2021**, after which tenders will be opened in public.
2. Tender submission shall be:
 - **One (1) hard copy of the document completed in full with all attachments**
 - **Bidders can bid for more than one package however a bidder will only be appointed for a maximum of two packages.**
3. The tender will remain valid for a period of **90 days** from the closing date for the submission of tenders.
4. Tenderers must submit with the tender documents, the **Tax Clearance Certificate and Municipal Rates Clearance Certificate** of the municipality where the business is registered and located in.
5. The Municipality reserves the right to accept a tender in full, partially or not at all and is not obliged to accept the lowest tender received.
6. The Municipality reserves the right to scale down on the scope of work in order for the contract value to fit into the available budget for the 2021/2022 financial year.

Telegraphic, telexed, faxed or emailed tenders will not be considered. Tenders that are not submitted in properly sealed and marked envelopes and/or deposited in the tender box as prescribed in this notice on the date and time indicated will NOT be opened or considered.
