



**TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER

South African National Parks invites tenders for the tender: **MOUNTAIN ZEBRA NATIONAL PARK – TAR AND GRAVEL ROAD MAINTENANCE**

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The following tenderers who are registered with the CIDB, or are capable of being so registered prior to the evaluation of submissions are eligible to submit tenders:

- a) It is estimated that tenderers must have a CIDB contractor grading **5 CE** or higher.
- b) Contractors registered as potentially emerging enterprises with the CIDB who are registered in one contractor grading designation lower than that required in terms of a) and who satisfy the criteria: **4 CEPE**.
and
- c) Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders provided that:
 - i) every member of the joint venture is registered with the CIDB
 - ii) the lead partner has a contractor grading designation in the **5 CE** class of the construction work
 - The combined contractor grading designation calculated in accordance with the Construction Industry Development Regulations is equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered of **5CE** class of construction work or a value determined in accordance with the Regulation 25 (1B) or 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations.
- d) Only tenderers who comply with the following are eligible to submit tenders:
 - Have the required and valid CIDB grading stated.
 - Achieved the minimum score for Functionality
 - Tenderer is not listed in the Register of Tender Defaulters and prohibited from doing business with the public sector.
 - The tenderer has not abused the Employer's supply chain management system
 - The tenderer has not failed to perform on any previous contract with the employer.

FUNCTIONALITY CRITERIA

Tenderers are required to demonstrate their ability to undertake the work and provide proof of experience in road re-sealing projects.

Tenderers are required to score a minimum of **8** points out of a possible **10** points in order to qualify for the tender.

Tenderers who fail to meet the minimum threshold shall be declared non-responsive and subsequently rejected. The onus rests with the tenderer to supply sufficient information to allow for the proper scoring, evaluation and award of points.

Where insufficient information is provided, zero points will be awarded for such particular criterion.

The functionality criteria and maximum score in respect of each of the criteria as follows:

A **compulsory clarification meeting** with representatives of the Employer will take place at the **Reception, Mountain Zebra National Park (32°13'25.18"S; 25°28'47.06"E)** in the **Mountain Zebra National Park off the R61 National Road in Cradock, Eastern Cape** on **01 August 2024 starting at 11:00 hrs. Prospective tenderers who arrive later than 11h20 will not be allowed into the Clarification meeting.** The Tenderer shall inspect and examine the Site and its surroundings and shall satisfy himself before submitting his tender as to the form and nature of the Site, the quantities and nature of the work and materials necessary for the completion of the Works and the means of access of the Site, the accommodation he may require and in general shall himself obtain all necessary information as to risk, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect his tender. The tenderer must be represented at the site inspection by a person who is suitably qualified and experienced to comprehend the implications of the work involved. Attendance of the site inspection is compulsory, and a tender will be disqualified if the site inspection is not attended by a representative of the tenderer.

The closing time for receipt of tenders is 22 August 2024 @ 11:00 hrs. Telephonic, facsimile, e-mail and late tenders will not be accepted.

Tenders may only be submitted on the tender documentation that is issued.

Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of tenders are stated in the Tender Data.

Tenders in sealed envelopes marked clearly with the identification details: **“Tender CI-GK-0172: MOUNTAIN ZEBRA NATIONAL PARK – TAR AND GRAVEL ROAD MAINTENANCE, Eastern Cape Province** must be deposited ONLY in the tender box at **Reception, Mountain Zebra National Park, Off the R61 National Road in Cradock, Eastern Cape, (32°13’25.18”S; 25°28’47.06”E)**, on or before the stated closing date and time.

Telephonic, facsimile, e-mail and late tenders will not be accepted.
Tenders may only be submitted on the tender documentation issued.
