

SPECIFICATION FOR WEBSITE HOSTING SERVICES AND SSL CERTIFICATE WITH MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT FOR A PERIOD OF 36 MONTHS

1. INTRODUCTION

Gateway Airports Authority Limited (GAAL) seeks to appoint a suitably qualified, reputable, and experienced service provider to acquire website hosting services and renewal of SSL certificate with maintenance and support for a period of 36 months. The appointed service provider must provide website hosting to assist with securing the entity's DNS records and enable customers to access a secure website.

The website is currently being developed by a third party awaiting to go live however, a service provider is required to assist with hosting, transferring of domain and DNS records to an independent/dedicated account that is managed and will solely belong to GAAL. Furthermore, provide a dedicated web server, that will belong to GAAL upon handing over, ensure that GAAL's designated officials and the third party have access to the hosted server during implementation of the services and upon expiry of the contract. The service provider must make provision for unlimited web traffic.

The service provider must ensure that the SSL certificate is renewed and the website is hosted in an efficient operating condition throughout the applicable contract period. Despite any challenges or disputes, the service provider shall ensure that there are no disruptions to GAAL business operations, the service shall always be available and functional 365 days a year, 24 hours and 7 days a week. The service provider must provide on the job training and skills transfer to GAAL's IT officials on website hosting, transfer of domain and DNS records to mitigate the risk of disruptions on the service and on expiry of the contract post the handing over. There must be provision of a system in place to record all logged calls and ensure that all products within a company meet consistent standards and function properly.

The service provider must understand and practice quality management in providing ICT solutions and services relating to ISO 9001 and understand policies about securing client data, business reputation and information management relating to ISO/IEC 27001. With technological changes daily, it is a requirement for added and improved functionality of the website security, adaptive enhancement and perfective maintenance to capacitate the

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Information Technology infrastructure. Full comprehensive testing and quality assurance must be conducted prior to signing off the project and payment of any invoices.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

2.1 SPECIFICATIONS

The potential service provider must be able to render the following services for a period of 36 months as per below specification requirements.

- Provision of website hosting services and renewal of multi-domain SSL certificate with maintenance and support for a period of 36 months.
- Transfer of domain and DNS records to an independent hosting account that will belong to GAAL.
- Provide website hosting to assist with securing the entities DNS records and enable customers to access a secure website.
- Ensure that the SSL certificate is renewed accordingly, and the website is hosted in an efficient operating condition throughout the applicable contract period.
- Make provision for unlimited web traffic.
- Provide a dedicated web server that will belong to GAAL upon handing over and for security.
- Ensure that there are no disruptions to GAAL business operations, the service shall always be available and functional 365 days a year, 24 hours and 7 days a week.
- Conduct skills transfer/on the job training and change management which includes management of all hosted services and SSL certificates.
- Service provider shall ensure that there is concurrent skills transfer or on the job training to GAAL IT officials on website hosting, transfer of domain and DNS records.
- Ensure that skills transfer/on the job training is led by skills transfer plan for official transfer/handing over of the website hosting services to the entity; This shall happen during the term of the contract to minimize the risk of disruptions, for business continuity during the implementation of the service and post handing over of the entire project.

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- Ensure that GAAL's designated officials and the third party have access to the hosted server during implementation of the services and upon expiry of the contract.
- Make provision for unlimited web traffic.
- Ensure that there is proper reporting management which includes attendance of quarterly or monthly service meetings and provision of performance reports in accordance with the Service Level Agreement (SLA).
- Attend SLA meetings with the GAAL and the third party that developed the website and is providing maintenance and support of the website.
- Service and respond to logged calls by GAAL.
- The service provider shall ensure that there is service availability and functionality without downtime; time availability and matrix penalties will be fully documented on the Service Level Agreement based on functionality, risk assessment and information classification.
- There must be a system in place to allocate a reference number for all service calls made by GAAL, which shall serve as proof that the call was made.
- Provide web server system integrity tests during software upgrades by client.
- Provide web server system hosting – Storage and compute.
- System backup and restore tests services.
- Automated backup processes and backup media management.
- Upgrade the webserver system software.
- The service provider must understand policies about securing GAAL's data, business reputation and information management relating to ISO/IEC 27001

2.2 FORMULATION OF THE PROBLEM

- ☐ Provision of up-to-date and secure website hosting.
- ☐ Provision of web management, enable access to information and for customers to access secure website.
- ☐ Provision of SSL Certificates and upgrades of all required software.
- ☐ Transfer of Domain and DNS records.

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- ☐ Information security vulnerability management to prevent and mitigate vulnerabilities and possible risks from negatively impacting business activities.
- ☐ Adaptive enhancement and perfective maintenance to capacitate the Information Technology infrastructure and improved functionality of an inviting website.
- ☐ Provision of unlimited web traffic and dedicated web server that will belong to GAAL upon handing over and for security.
- ☐ Fully adhere to GAAL's and the third party's requirements to assist and ensure that the website goes live.

2.3 METHODOLOGY

The potential service provider must provide a clear project charter, implementation plan and methodology approach that includes the following:

- Project deliverables
- Project timeline
- Testing and Quality Assurance
- Training
- Implementation
- Maintenance and Support
- Business continuity plan to avoid downtime.

3. EVALUATION CRITERIA

All quotations will be evaluated in terms of administrative/mandatory requirements, functionality/functional requirements and preference point system.

3.1 Gate 0: Administrative (mandatory) requirements

Supplier (s) must submit the documents listed in **Table 1** below. All documents must be completed and signed in black ink by the duly authorised representative of the prospective bidder(s). **Correction fluid is not allowed and any cancellation on the bid document must be initialled by the authorized signatory.** During this phase, Bidders' responses will be evaluated based on compliance with the listed administration and mandatory bid requirements. The bidder(s) quotation will be disqualified for non-submission of any of the documents.

3.2. Gate 2: Functionality Evaluation Criteria

All bidders are required to respond to the functionality evaluation criteria.

Only Bidders that have met the Administrative and/or Mandatory Criteria in (Gate 0) will be evaluated in Gate 1 for functionality as per below table:

Functionality Evaluation – Bidders will be evaluated out of 130 points and are required to achieve minimum threshold of 95 points to proceed to Gate 2 for Price and Specific goals evaluations; and

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As part of due diligence, the entity may conduct a site visit at the bidders' place of business (as per the physical address provided by the bidder on SBD1) and/or at client of the Bidder (reference) for validation of the services previously rendered.

- 5.2.1 Bidders' attention is drawn to the fact that amendments to any of the bid conditions or setting of counter conditions by bidders may result in the invalidation of such bids.

- 5.3.1 GAAL reserves the right to negotiate with the preferred bidders prior to award and with the successful bidders(s) post award.

- 5.5.2 Any actual discrepancy, ambiguity, error or inconsistency in this bid or any other information provided by the GAAL will, if possible, be corrected and provided to all bidders without attribution to the bidder who provided the written notice.
- 5.5.3 All communication between the bidder and Supply Chain Management office must be done in writing.

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- 1.5 Failure on the part of a tenderer to submit proof or documentation required in terms of this tender to claim points for specific goals with the tender, will be interpreted to mean that preference points for specific goals are not claimed.
- 1.6 The organ of state reserves the right to require of a tenderer, either before a tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.

2. DEFINITIONS

- (a) **“tender”** means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation to provide goods or services through price quotations, competitive tendering process or any other method envisaged in legislation;
- (b) **“price”** means an amount of money tendered for goods or services, and includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (c) **“rand value”** means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;
- (d) **“tender for income-generating contracts”** means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation for the origination of income-generating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the organ of state and a third party that produces revenue for the organ of state, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions; and

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$$Ps = 80 \left(1 - \frac{Pt - P_{min}}{P_{min}} \right) \quad \text{or} \quad Ps = 90 \left(1 - \frac{Pt - P_{min}}{P_{min}} \right)$$

- Ps = Points scored for price of tender under consideration
Pt = Price of tender under consideration
Pmin = Price of lowest acceptable tender

3.2. FORMULAE FOR DISPOSAL OR LEASING OF STATE ASSETS AND INCOME GENERATING PROCUREMENT

3.2.1. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

A maximum of 80 or 90 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

- 4.1. In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender. For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based on the goals stated in table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:
- 4.2. In cases where organs of state intend to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that, if it is unclear whether the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system applies, an organ of state must, in the tender documents, stipulate in

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the case of—

- (a) an invitation for tender for income-generating contracts, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the highest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system; or
- (b) any other invitation for tender, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the lowest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system, then the organ of state must indicate the points allocated for specific goals for both the 90/10 and 80/20 preference point system.

 - (b) recover costs, losses or damages it has incurred or suffered as a result of that person's conduct;
 - (c) cancel the contract and claim any damages which it has suffered as a result of having to make less favourable arrangements due to such cancellation;
 - (d) recommend that the tenderer or contractor, its shareholders and directors, or only the shareholders and directors who acted on a fraudulent basis, be restricted from obtaining business from any organ of state for a period not exceeding 10 years, after the *audi alteram partem* (hear the other side) rule has been applied; and
