#	QUESTION	RESPONSE
1.	Do bidders need to have backups Cylinders, along with the oxygen concentrators? Do they also need to have a refilling system in place so that we can refill those surrenders?	All patients must be allocated with a concentrator and a backup oxygen cylinders to be utilised in the absence of electricity.
2.	If a bidder has a CE or FDA certificate, do they also need to have a SANAS Certificate?	Quality assurance certificates and product standard certificates required to proof compliance for relevant product is indicated on the SCC.
3.	Are we able to get a breakdown in terms of the consumption, number of cylinders in terms of the tanks or per kgs that are required per province?	Information regarding number of patients to be serviced every month is provided to determined consumption rate estimates
4.	Would it be compulsory for oxygen concentrators to have backup power, or should it be quoted separately?	The main equipment used by the patient is the oxygen concentrators, the Oxygen Cylinders are used as a backup for medical oxygen.
