	A Technical prequalification has been set for the submission of a valid Letter of Good Standing with the Workmen's compensation fund by the tendering entity or separate Letters of Good Standing from all members of a newly constituted JV. (The Nature of Business be must in line with what the bidder in tendering for) T2.2-04 Evaluation Schedule: Programme, Out of the 100 points, 15 are located to the programme . Read the questions and answer accordingly, look at the criteria, all of them have been allocated a mark and out of those marks there is a threshold. For example, your programme must show a starting and completion date, if you submit a programme with a starting date which is before the indicated projected commencement date, that will be a non-responsive programme. You must use the date indicated in the contract data as a point of reference when formulating your programme. 	The scope is for the refurbishment of 4 pilot boats which are in various ports. One is in the Port of Cape Town, two are in Saldanha and one is at the Port of Durban. Within the port system we have eleven pilot boats and all those pilot boats have surpassed their designated lifespan, with the oldest being the Ballito currently in Durban and Inyoni sitting at 38 years. Then we have Garnett and Petrel around 33 years. Seven of the eight commercial ports utilise pilot boats and around the port system we are averaging around 1500 vessels docking and sailing monthly. Therefore, we really need these pilot boats operational, safe and class certified because without them we will not be able to deploy our masters to the vessels which will result in TNPA being non-operational. Garnett tug is out of class. It will be the responsibility of the preferred bidder to ensure that if there is a dry-docking requirement you make those arrangements yourself.	Motsamai Mohoalali

 - an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people;
 - an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are youth;
 - an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are women;
 - an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people with disabilities;
 - an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people living in rural or underdeveloped areas or townships;
 - a cooperative which is at least 51% owned by black people;
 - an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are military veterans.
