3. STANDARD CONDITIONS OF TENDER

- Please quote the tender enquiry number on all correspondence.

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- Please take note of the STANDARD CONDITIONS OF TENDER, (July 2000) noted in this letter and any amendments that accompany the TENDER. The tenderer should understand that his / her signed Offer to Purchase serves as his legal agreement to the Standard conditions of tender.

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4. SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work will entail the marketing and advertising to the local market, Eskom employees communication sites, of the vehicles for sale on behalf of Eskom Fleet Department. It will also be an inherent obligation to complete and prepare all the necessary documentation for the buyer's permit to be able to remove and transport the vehicles from Eskom site to their respective places. The total sale must be concluded within a reasonable period (3 working days), once the successful disposal auctioneer has been afforded the relevant information from Eskom. The sale of vehicles will start with Eskom staff and any vehicles unsold will be sold to the public auction which will be organised within five days after the staff auction.

NOTES

- A report shall be supplied by the disposal agent upon completion of the sale indicating within three (3) working days.

The Auctioneer will be responsible to collect payment from the buyer. Payment shall be made to Eskom no later than two days after the date of the sale. The release of the vehicle/equipment to the new buyer will

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take place after receipt of payment to Eskom and the buyer acquiring a permit to remove and transport the vehicle/equipment.

The commission will be calculated on the prices obtained on the sale exclusive of VAT.

The auctioneer must include with the tender a single page letter of introduction. Auction must take place within 15 days after the successful tenderer has been notified.

- b. Eskom will not be responsible for any damages or losses suffered during the removal of the vehicles incurred while working on this project arising from theft, damage or personal injury.
- c. You will be required to adhere to the condition as laid out by the Eskom site agent with regards to site access etc.
- d. Littering is prohibited at all times. Facilities will have to be made available on site during dismantling operations for the collection of disposal waste material. No rubble whatsoever is to be left on site.
- e. You will be required to be put on an Eskom permit, prior to commencement of and work. After completion of the work, it is imperative that you notify the Eskom site agent, so that the job can be signed off.
- f. All work must comply with the OHSA Act no 85 of 1993. All Safety requirements and documentation shall be available on the site
- g. No accommodation will be allowed on site and auctioneer must come with his or her own equipment.

5. Environmental requirements

The intended activities at the site will have an impact on the environment and as such have to be properly management. Proper management requires that there is compliance with all the relevant pieces of legislation that impact on the development or intended activities. Eskom reserves the right not to accept the lowest or any tender / offer or withdraw any item it wishes to retain.

Only the successful tenderer will be notified.

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8. VALUE ADDED TAX (VAT)

Value Added Tax Act no 89 Of 1991 and VAT invoices will be issued on request.

DECLARATION (BY TENDERERS) OF GOOD STANDING REGARDING TAX

IT IS A CONDITION OF TENDERERS THAT:

8.1 It is an absolute requirement that the taxes of the successful tenderer must be in order, or that suitable arrangement is made with the Receiver of Revenue to satisfy them.
