1. General submission

- 1.2. The bidder(s) are required to submit four (4) copies where, one (1) original and three (3) duplicates. Each copy must be marked correctly and sealed separately for ease of reference during the evaluation process.

2. Payment

- 2.1. CHIETA will pay the fees set out in the final contract according to the table of deliverables and no additional amounts will be payable.



2.2. The contractor shall from time to time during the duration of the contract, invoice CHIETA for the services rendered and CHIETA shall pay invoices due within 30 days.

2.3. The invoice shall be accompanied by supporting source document(s) containing detailed information, as CHIETA may require, for the purposes of establishing the specific nature, extent and quality of the services which were undertaken by the Contractor.

2.4. No payment will be made to the Contractor unless an original tax invoice complying with section 20 of the VAT Act No 89 of 1991, as amended, has been submitted to CHIETA.

2.5. Payment shall be made by bank transfer into the Contractor's bank account normally 30 days after receipt of an acceptable, original, valid tax invoice. Money will only be transferred into a South African bank account (CHIETA will make payment only on verified accounts and that appear on Central Supplier Database.)

2.6. The Contractor shall be responsible for accounting to the appropriate authorities for its income tax, VAT or other moneys required to be paid in terms of the applicable law.

7. Evaluation and Selection criteria

The CHIETA has set minimum standards (Gates) that bidders must meet to be considered.
