PART T1.1: TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER

- Closing Date on **Friday 23 September 2022** at **11:00**,
- **R.056-050-2023/1F** Only tenderers with a B-BBEE contributor status level of 1, 2, 3 or 4, are eligible to tender
- Joint Ventures (JV) will be allowed on condition that one JV partner is a Targeted Enterprise:
