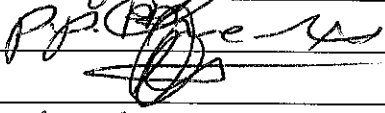
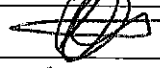
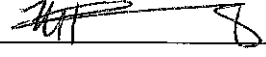

1. PURPOSE

- 1.1 To seek approval to appoint Primedia Broadcasting, for the Department of Military Veterans (DMV) – Department Services Freedom Month campaign according to Supply Chain Management delegations 4.3.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The DMV has a number of programmes which are aimed at the socio economic empowerment of all military veterans both statutory and non-statutory forces. The top priority programmes for the DMV are delivered through the following benefits: skills development, education support, housing, health and wellness, and job creation, and honouring and memorialization.
- 2.2 The DMV wants to profile conversations with struggle heroes from the different military veterans' association and talk where we come from as a country, and why it is important to preserve the hard-earned freedom.
- 2.3 It is against this background that the DMV has requested the Government Communication Information System (GCIS) Media Buying to assist with the media placement for this campaign.

3. CAMPAIGN OBJECTIVES

- 3.1 To profile and create awareness about the DMV and the services provided.
- 3.2 To profile the background of the freedom as a country.

4. TARGET MARKET

- 4.1 GSM 1 – 5: Rooted Realists, City Seekers, Safely Suburban, Metro Mobiles and Cosmopolitan Capital.
- 4.2 Gauteng province.

5. CAMPAIGN PERIOD

- 5.1 27 April 2023.

6. RECOMMENDATION

6.1.1 Based on the campaign background and research analysis conducted, Media Buying recommends the use of Radio with a listenership of 36 741 000. Radio is an interactive medium that allows engagements with the listeners hence.

6.1.2 It needs to be noted that a separate submission will be done for community radio to amplify the campaign to have a national reach.

6.1.3 Out of home (OOH) and TV have a higher audience, however OOH is not recommended as it does not provide an engagement with the audience and TV requires production lead times of 7 – 14 days.

6.2 Delegation 4.3 Radio threshold R 3 000 000.00. Campaign total is R354,359.52 including VAT.

6.2.1 Radio 702 is recommended because the Department has previously implemented campaigns on African Language Stations and other stations such as Metro FM and Power FM. Further to this the Department is targeting Segments 4 and 5 with this campaign to provide them with insights and profile those man and women who fought for the freedom of this country. The Department is also using this campaign to counter negative sentiments, which the higher segment might have about the department by sharing these feel good stories of heroes of the struggle. Media Buying recommends the use of talk orientated station.

6.2.2 Radio 702 (PRIMEDIA Broadcasting). The recommended station has a listenership of 643 000 in Gauteng and is the highest amongst talk radio stations in the province. Radio 702 keeps the audience connected to current affairs

through in-depth conversations, analysis on various topics, and provides the listeners the ability to comment and have a dialogue.

6.2.3 Radio 702 will provide a 30-minute conversation platform with add-ons such as promos, content recaps, and social media posts. This is an effective package for the campaign as it allows the campaign to spread to social media and this has the ability to audience to comment, share content, and improve engagement while receiving direct feedback from the audience.

6.2.4 The Department will also share the podcasts with the stories with other radio stations for them to flight as documentaries.

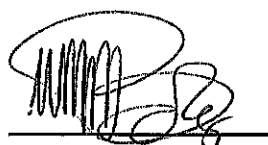
NOT RECOMMENDED

6.2.5 Metro FM, Ukhozi FM, Lesedi FM, 947, Thobela FM, Motsweding FM, Jacaranda FM, and YFM have higher audience in Gauteng however they are not recommended as these are entertainment stations and will not be effective for long format discussions. It needs to be noted that although these stations may provide current affairs content, they provide limited conversations, as their mandate is not a 24-hour talk format station.

7. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

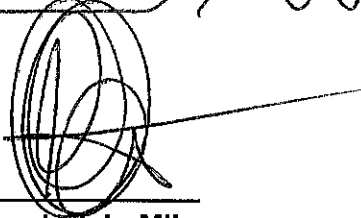

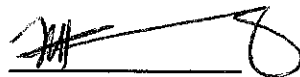

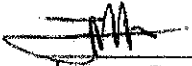

For this reason, a disclaimer is displayed for supply chain practitioners to obtain supporting documentation to verify the identity and legitimacy of a supplier in these cases.

Bank

BBBEE

CSD does not automatically verify all certificate information with the various accreditation bodies. Organs of State are required, where not automatically verified by CSD, to manually verify this information with the applicable accreditation body as per current policies and procedures. Expired certificate information do not reflect on the report.

RESTRICTION

Restricted Supplier - A supplier is restricted by using the identification number of the entity e.g. CIPC registration, trust, Social Development non-profit, South African ID, Foreign company registration number or ID number. If there is more than one CSD Supplier profile registered on CSD with the same entity identification number, all those related supplier profiles will be restricted.

Restricted Director - A director/owner is an individual person and is restricted by using the South African ID or Foreign ID number. If a director belongs to different companies and has been restricted, the director will reflect as restricted in all companies where identification number is detected.

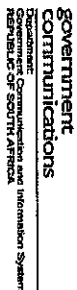
