1. INTRODUCTION TO THE NRF

The South African Astronomical Observatory (SAAO) is a facility of the National Research Foundation and is the national centre for optical and infrared astronomy in South Africa. Its prime function is to conduct fundamental research in astronomy and astrophysics by providing a world-class facility and by promoting astronomy and astrophysics in Southern Africa.

2. SUPPLY SPECIFICATIONS

SAAO invites the submission of quotations for the following:

Request for Quotation for a **Registered Accredited Fire Prevention and Protection Service Provider** who is registered with relevant authorities (minimum SAQCC) to provide testing and servicing of fire extinguishers and supply of new SABS approved fire extinguisher cylinders and accessories at SAAO Cape Town and Sutherland, Northern-Cape for a period of **three (3) years**. The Service Provider shall comply with all applicable government legislation.

Accommodation and meals at the Sutherland facility in the Northern-Cape will be provided by SAAO Sutherland. Suppliers must indicate number of personnel (no more than three (3) personnel and not more than one (1) over-night stay at the SAAO Sutherland accommodation facility).

4.5. I, the undersigned, who is duly authorised to do so on behalf of the company/firm, certify that the points claimed, based on the specific goals as advised in the tender, qualifies the company/ firm for the preference(s) shown and I acknowledge that:
