iThemba LABS (Laboratory for Accelerator-Based Sciences) is a multi-disciplinary research laboratory based at two sites in the Western Cape and Gauteng respectively, these provide facilities for:

- ☐ Research Radiation Biophysics
- ☐ The supply of Accelerator-produced Radioactive Isotopes for Nuclear Medicine and Research

3. CONTEXT OF THIS PROCUREMENT NEED

iThemba LABS has pioneered the Portable African Neutron-Gamma Laboratory for Innovative Nuclear Science (PANGoLINS) project which deploys sensitive radiation equipment to operate in the field and chart the location, strength and energy of gamma radiation. Airborne deployment will need both access to suitable research sites, pilots, uncrewed airborne systems for research activities. In addition, expertise is requested to assist our local crafts and pilots in order to finalise measurements on site.

iThemba LABS invites quotations from suitably qualified individuals, organisations, aviation clubs and licensed Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) operators for the provision of land access, operational support, technical consultation, and optional pilot and drone services to support UAS-based research activities including the aerial deployment of an iThemba LABS supplied research payload under the service provider's operational responsibility and approvals. A significant portion of the work will be undertaken at iThemba LABS, Cape Town facilities, including planning, mission preparation, testing, integration activities, technical consultation, and operational support. Field trials require a suitable off-site flight area and temporary placement of sealed radioactive point sources on the ground. iThemba

LABS will manage the sources and applicable radiation authorisations through its radiation-protection personnel.

Operational Support and Consultation

The successful respondent shall provide operational support and expert consultation throughout the contract period. This may include mission planning, technical advice, flight-test planning, support at iThemba LABS facilities in Cape Town, site assessments, safety reviews, and assistance with research flight operations. Consultation will include assistance in regulatory procedures including registration of iThemba LABS own craft, certification - Unmanned Aircraft System Operator Certificate (UASOC), and Unmanned Aircraft System Letter of Authority (UASLA) for corporate operations.

Information Required from Respondents

Provide site details, landowner permissions, safety measures, restrictions, organisational information, consultation capability, pilot/drone capability, experience, and pricing information.

Optional Additional Capabilities

Pilot services and access to suitable drones are optional. Where offered, flights shall be conducted under a valid UASOC. Submit the UASOC, relevant operations specifications and insurance, and identify site-specific flight permissions held or to be obtained before trials.

Provision of Qualified Drone Pilots

Submit proof of valid Remote Pilot Licence/Certificate (RPL/RPC), relevant endorsements, experience with suitable Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS), availability, and pricing. iThemba LABS reserves the right to approve proposed pilots.

Supplier-Provided Drones

Provide UAS model details, technical specifications, aircraft registration and UAS Letter of Authority (UASLA), and suitability for the intended research activities. All UASs remain subject to approval by iThemba LABS.

Research Payloads

iThemba LABS will provide 3 kg research payload for supplier-provided drones. Payload integration and compatibility with aviation, navigation and communications systems shall be verified jointly with the service provider before research flights.

1.5 Failure on the part of a tenderer to submit proof or documentation required in terms of this tender to claim points for specific goals with the tender, will be interpreted to mean that preference points for specific goals are not claimed.

- 1.6 The organ of state reserves the right to require of a tenderer, either before a tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.

2. DEFINITIONS

- (a) “tender” means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation to provide goods or services through price quotations, competitive tendering process or any other method envisaged in legislation;
- (b) “price” means an amount of money tendered for goods or services, and includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (c) “rand value” means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;
- (d) “tender for income-generating contracts” means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation for the origination of income-generating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the organ of state and a third party that produces revenue for the organ of state, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions; and
